

New Granny Flat Legislation, Legacy range

At our recent event with the Northland Property Investors Association, we explored the upcoming changes to the Granny Flat Legislation and the opportunities it will create for property owners and investors.

The Building and Construction Amendment Bill passed its first reading in parliament on the 26th of May and is now with the Select Committee. With strong support, it's likely to pass by the end of the year and take effect in early 2026. The changes open the door for consent-free minor dwellings up to 70m2. For investors this translates into reduced costs and barriers to development, additional income streams from rental opportunities and higher capital value.
